

Major Maintenance Checklist - Cayenne V6 (2008)

Required Maintenance and Lubrication Service

■ Major Maintenance (Labor Operation 03 26 00) See Technical Manual After 36,000, 72,000, 108,000, 144,000 miles etc. / 60,000, 120,000, 180,000, 240,000 km etc.		
Note: If the mileage for scheduled maintenance is not reached, major maintenance must be performed no later than after 4, 8, 12 years.		
The terms 'check' and 'inspection' include all necessary subsequent work such as adjusting, readjusting, correcting and topping off, but do not include repairing, replacing and reconditioning parts or assemblies.		
☐ Diagnosis system: Read out fault memory; reset maintenance interval		
☐ Underside of vehicle and engine compartment: Visual inspection for leaks (oil and fluids)		
Engine compartment: Visual inspection for damage		
Underbody covers: Visual inspection, check that all are securely fastened – replace any damaged or missing panels Change engine oil and oil filter (Cayenne V6 which is 10,000 miles/15,000 km, see separate Oil Change Sheet, PNA 000 162 CC)		
PDCC: Check fluid level		
☐ Air filter/s: Check the air filter condition, and if necessary, replace		
Pollen filter: Replace filter element		
☐ Check drive belt		
■ Steering gear: Visual inspection of the dust boots for signs of damage		
Tie rod ends: Check play and dust boots		
☐ Power steering: Check fluid level		
☐ Fuel system lines and connections: Visual inspection		
☐ Coolant hoses: Check condition		
Radiators and air intakes: Visual inspection for exterior debris and blockage		
Coolant: Check level and antifreeze protection levels		
☐ Parking brake: Check free play ☐ Brake system: Visual inspection of the brake pads and brake discs for signs of wear		
Brake hoses and lines: Visual inspection for damage, correct routing and corrosion Check brake fluid level		
Axle shafts: Visual inspection of the for leaks & signs of damage		
Axle joints: Check play; visual inspection of the dust boots for signs of damage		
Drive shafts: Visual inspection of the sleeves for leaks & signs of damage		
■ Exhaust system: Visual inspection for leaks and signs of damage; check mounts		
☐ Tires, external spare wheel: Check condition and tire pressure		
☐ Lubricate door latch and fastening bolts		
☐ Check firewall body drains for debris		
☐ Panorama roof: Adapt control module		
Windshield wiper/washer system, headlight washer: Check function, fluid level, nozzle adjustment, and antifreeze protection level		
☐ Check wiper blades		
☐ Seat belts: Check operation and condition		
■ Vehicle lighting: Check operation		
All headlights: Check adjustment		
Horn: Check operation		
Batteries and ventilation hoses: Check condition		
Trailer coupling: Check operation		
Airbag system: Check operation and condition (see additional maintenance)		
Additional Maintenance every 36,000 miles / 60,000 km or 4 years (Labor Operation 03 81 00)		
Replace spark plugs		
Additional Maintenance every 54,000 miles / 90,000 km or 6 years (Labor Operation 03 83 00) Replace PDCC reservoir		
Additional Maintenance every 72,000 miles / 120,000 km or 4 years (Labor Operation 03 85 00) Air filter element/s should be changed more often dependent on vehicle use and operation in dusty environments. Air filter element/s (1 or 2 dependent on options)		

Additional Maintenance every 144,000 miles / 240,000	km or 16 years
